Conditions of Entry

1. Each competitor, (open age) may enter up to 3 works only. The entry must be the original work of the competitor.
 2. Entries may be for sale. If sold there will be a commission of 30 % for handling expenses and a third of that fee will go towards the costs of biodiversity education in Kimberley schools (Photographers are welcome to put more of the sale money towards that cause).
 3. THEME : “What’s in Your Backyard?”
 4. THE SIZE OF THE WORK must not exceed ...
Photographs 100 x 100 cm or 10,000sq cm. (incl. any framing) or 10 MB for electronic entries.
 5. ENTRIES must arrive at **Kimberley Toad Busters** (Ivanhoe Rd, Second driveway of right past Research Station Rd), via PO Box 1188, Kununurra 6743, or delivered to **Kununurra Visitors Centre** or can be emailed to photo@canetoads.com.au, no later than **Friday 12th March 2010**.
 6. Entries must be clearly marked on the back (bottom) with the name of photographer, Title of the work and contact. For electronic entries name of photographer, title and contact is required in the file name. Electronic entries will be printed out in A4 size for display at the Forum venue. An accompanying brief description / story / poem is acceptable but not compulsory.
 7. Competitors hereby consent to their work being reproduced for publicity connected with the ***Caring for the Kimberley Environmental Forum and Exhibition.***
 8. The Judges’ decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into. Judging will take place and Results will be announced, between 19 & 21st March 2010.
 9. Some works may be exhibited for a period of time after 21st March, at other venues around Kununurra, for the purpose of education about the risks to the Kimberley environment. These photographers will be notified. With consent some works will be used by Kimberley Toad Busters for biodiversity education and awareness activities. Copyright of the photographer will always be clearly acknowledged.
 10. All other works must be collected ...between **9am / 4pm between Tues 23rd and Sat 27th March 2010**, from **Kununurra Visitors Centre**.
 11. RETURNS.... If works can not be personally collected, the photographer should arrange for a courier/agent to collect. No returns will be made by either road or post, or expenses met by **Kimberley Toad Busters**.  12. Any works not claimed by the 31st March 2010 will be deemed to be unwanted and will be disposed of by Kimberley Toad Busters as they see fit.
 13. All care will be shown but no responsibility for damage or breakage will be taken by **Kimberley Toad Busters**, or any persons working or volunteering at the forum / exhibition. The art works are not insured while in our care and it is suggested that if the piece is of considerable value, the artist arranges their own insurance.
