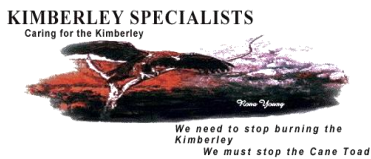


# KIMBERLEY TOAD BUSTERS.....

## Conditions of Entry

1. **THEME :** 'If everyone was a Toad Buster, the Toads would be BUSTED!'
  2. Any form of static display is welcomed, for example diorama or poster display. Displays are required to be kept within 2 meters by 2 meters by 1 metre. Children are encouraged to design a display to provide education on cane toad identification, impact of cane toads on biodiversity or how to bust toads safely.
  3. **ENTRIES** must be arrive at **Kimberley Toad Busters** (Ivanhoe Rd, Second driveway of right past Research Station Rd), PO Box 1188, or delivered to **Kununurra Visitors Centre**, Coolibah Drive, no later than **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2010**.   4. Entries must be clearly marked with the name of teacher, class and school. An accompanying brief description / story / poem is acceptable but not compulsory. Entries will be displayed as part of the Forum.
  5. Competitors hereby consent to their work being reproduced for publicity connected with the *Caring for the Kimberley Environmental Forum and Exhibition*.
  6. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into. Judging will take place and results will be announced, between 19 & 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010.
  7. Some works may be exhibited for a period of time after 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010, at other venues around Kununurra, for the purpose of education about the risks to the Kimberley environment. These classes and schools will be notified.
  8. All other works must be collected ...between **9am / 4pm between Tues 23<sup>rd</sup> and Sat 27<sup>th</sup> March 2010** from **Kununurra Visitors Centre**.
  9. **RETURNS....** If works can not be personally collected, the school should arrange for a courier/agent to collect. No returns will be made by either road or post, or expenses met by **Kimberley Toad Busters**.   10. Any works not claimed by the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010 will be deemed to be unwanted and will be disposed of by Kimberley Toad Busters as they see fit.
  11. All care will be shown but no responsibility for damage or breakage will be taken by **Kimberley Toad Busters**, or any persons working or volunteering at the forum / exhibition.
